




TERROIR SERIES

• TERROIR

Alluvial, derived from the water erosion of the Andes Mountains. Dry conditions and wide thermal amplitude during the day, creating a very distinctive microclimate. The sandy-textured soils are skeletal and quite deep, enabling deeply colored and highly structured wines.

DESCRIPTION

Bright greenish yellow colour. On the nose, floral notes and aromas of fruit such as apricot, mango and pineapple combined with subtle hints of nuts. Aromas of toast and vanilla give complexity to this wine. Cool and soft, this wine displays a balanced acidity integrated with the sweetness of the fruit. Oak ageing provides structure and a long aftertaste resulting in a complex wine with a great aromatic persistence.
