Tupungato, Uco Valley.

• ALTITUDE
1110 masl.

• TERROIR
Alluvial, derived from the water erosion of the Andes Mountains. Dry conditions and wide thermal amplitude during the day, creating a very distinctive microclimate. The sandy-textured soils are skeletal and quite deep, enabling deeply colored and highly structured wines.

• DESCRIPTION
Intense ruby red color with violet tints. On the nose, red fruits and plum jams stands out and combine with herbal and spicy notes bringing a particular freshness. Its passage through oak provides subtle notes of caramel and vanilla. The palate is concentrated and intense, juicy with a refreshing and elegante acidity. Very good structure and persistence in the mouth.
