A COOL CLIMATE COMBINED WITH EXCELLENT SUN EXPOSURE AND SOIL STRUCTURES RESULT IN WELL- BALANCED WINES THAT DISPLAY THE TRUE CHARACTERISTICS OF THEIR VARIETIES.

• ORIGIN
Tunuyán, Uco Valley.

• ALTITUDE
1300 masl.

• TERROIR
Alluvial, derived from the water erosion of the Andes Mountains. Dry conditions and wide thermal amplitude during the day, creating a very distinctive microclimate. The sandy-textured soils are skeletal and quite deep, enabling deeply colored and highly structured wines.

• DESCRIPTION
Ruby red colour with soft violet tones. Intense and complex nose, with outstanding fruity aromas such as strawberries and black plums, with subtle notes of fresh herbs with a mineral touch. In the mouth, it is sweet and rounded, with soft tannins and a delicate acidity that provides structure to the wine. Long aftertaste.
